All Plein Air artists are invited to paint on location at 6 beautiful, historic buildings listed below. We've been very fortunate in obtaining permission to paint on the grounds of The Burrage Mansion and at Kimberly Crest, and urge artists to take advantage of these "once in a lifetime" opportunities. Artists are invited to enter the resulting artworks for the Show-Within-A-Show at the Redlands Art Association gallery, 215 East State Street. Take-in for artworks is on Saturday, April 9 from 12-4. Pick-up unsold artworks on Sunday, after 4:30 pm, and also on Monday from 10-5. Maximum size is 36 inches in the longest dimension, including frame, and paintings must be dry, framed and securely wired for hanging. The entry fee is \$15 for the first entry and \$5 for each additional entry, with a maximum of 3 entries per artist. Art sales will be handled through the Redlands Art Association, with 30% commission shared equally by the RAA and the RC. The reception and awards ceremony will be held in conjunction with the Spring Flower Show reception at the RAA gallery on Saturday, April 16 from 2-4. Elin Pendleton will judge the show for cash prizes: \$150 for First Place, \$100 for Second, \$50 for Third as well as Honorable Mention ribbons.

1. **Santa Fe Depot**, Wednesday, March 9, 9-1. 349 Orange St. Park in lot behind the depot. Bathrooms and refreshments available nearby.

2. **Artist's Choice**, Saturday, March 12. Paint at the Santa Fe Depot, the Asistencia, Old City Hall or the Lincoln Shrine.

3. **The Burrage Mansion**, Wednesday, March 16, 9-1. 1205 W. Crescent Ave. Park along Crescent. No bathrooms.

4. **The Asistencia Mission**, Saturday, March 19, 10-3. 26930 Barton Road. Park in lot to the East. Bathrooms and water available inside.

5. **Kimberly Crest**, Wednesday, March 23, 12-5. 1325 Prospect Dr. Entrance on Highland Ave. across from Alvarado St. Gated drive will be open, with parking lot left and below the house. No bathrooms.

6. **Old City Hall**, Saturday, March 26, 9-1. 30 Cajon St. Park on Cajon or Vine streets. Bathrooms and refreshments nearby.

7. **Artist's Choice**, Wednesday, March 30. Paint at the Santa Fe Depot, the Asistencia, Old City Hall or the Lincoln Shrine.

8. **The Lincoln Shrine**, Saturday, April 2, 9-1. 125 W. Vine St. Park on street or in lot on corner of Citrus and Fourth Streets. Bathrooms and water available in the Smiley Library after 10 am.

Artist's Choice days are included to encourage artists to paint together on these days, and artists are free to choose a location among the 4 public properties: The Santa Fe Depot, the Asistencia (hours are Tu-Sat, from 10-3), Old City Hall and the Lincoln Shrine. Artists may also choose to paint at times other than those listed, at their convenience, but artworks entered into the show MUST have been painted, on location, between March 9 and April 9, 2011. Entry to the Burrage Mansion and Kimberly Crest will NOT be available EXCEPT on the days and times listed for those location.
