SWEDEN - FROM SWEDISH DIRECTOR/WRITER LASSE HALLSTROM IN ENGLISH & SWEDISH WITH ENGLISH SUBTITLES STARRING LENA OLIN, TORA HALLSTROM.

Based on the life of Swedish painter Hilma af Klint (1862-1944)written and directed by Oscar nominee Lasse Hallström (CHOCOLAT, Cider House Rules) who brings to the forefront a female artist whose phenomenal works remained uncovered and unknown for 80 years, until 'THE SPIRITUAL IN ART ABSTRACT PAINTING' an exhibition in Los Angeles in 1986 followed by the Solomon Guggenheim Museum's exhibition 'HILMA AF KLINT:PAINTINGS FOR THE FUTURE' seen by over 600,000 visitors. Director Hallstrom has used his directorial paint brush to delve into Hilma's life which influenced her extraordinary abstract paintings with her

use of vibrant colors, geometry, science, spiritualism that were way ahead of her time. Featuring his daughter Tora Hallstrom as theyoung Hilma and his wife Oscar nominee Lena Olin (CHOCOLAT) as an Older Hilma. Hallstrom has again produced a beautiful film as he states "this is a story about an unwavering search for the truth about humanity and the universe, at a time when men set all the rules. Despite so many obstacles, Hilma created art that influences our lives today. My ambition is for the audience to experience these struggles with all their senses". A beautiful film not to be missed.

The dog follows her home and makes himself comfortable regardless of her attempts to get rid of him. His familiarity with her home and surroundings convinces her that Frank is reincarnated. Even more convincing is the dog's quick friendship with a young boy who yearns to join the school's Hurling team but is picked on by school bullies.

Halim (Saleh Bakri) and Mina (Lubna Azabal) run a traditional caftan store in one of Morocco's oldest Medinas. Halim is a craftsman who lovingly cuts, sews and embroiders each garment by hand in the tradition of his ancestors. Mina and Halim share a deep love for each other as they tend to their store and deal with the demands of irrational customers. They hire a young apprentice Youssef (Ayoub Missioui). As Mina deals with her progressing illness, she becomes uncomfortable with Youssef's presence as they depend on his help. This beautifully woven tender storyline not only captures the craftmanship of an ancient art but that of three unexpected relationships. This

is the second feature film of Maryam Touzani as director/writer & Nabil Ayouch as writer which they have produced since


their 2019 film ADAM screened here previously. Another beautiful film!

Berlin, 1942. Cioma Schönhaus (Louis Hofmann, star of the hit Netflix series Dark) is a young Jewish man who won't let anyone take away his zest for life, especially not the Nazis. Since the best hiding spots are in plain sight, Cioma audaciously adopts the identity of a marine officer to escape being deported like his family before him. Drawing on his art school background, he joins a network of underground rescuers and becomes infamous for his masterfully forged IDs – created with just a brush, some ink, and a steady hand – that save the lives of hundreds of Jews by allowing them to escape the country. His talent and propensity for boldness puts him in more and more danger.Director Peren states "it was important to me to raise awareness that racism doesn't come from nowhere".
